Please be assured that we appreciate your donations, even if we don't know who you are!

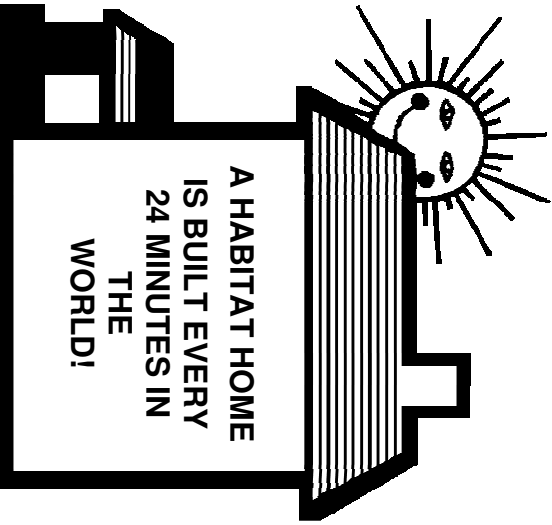
